SAFETY TIPS

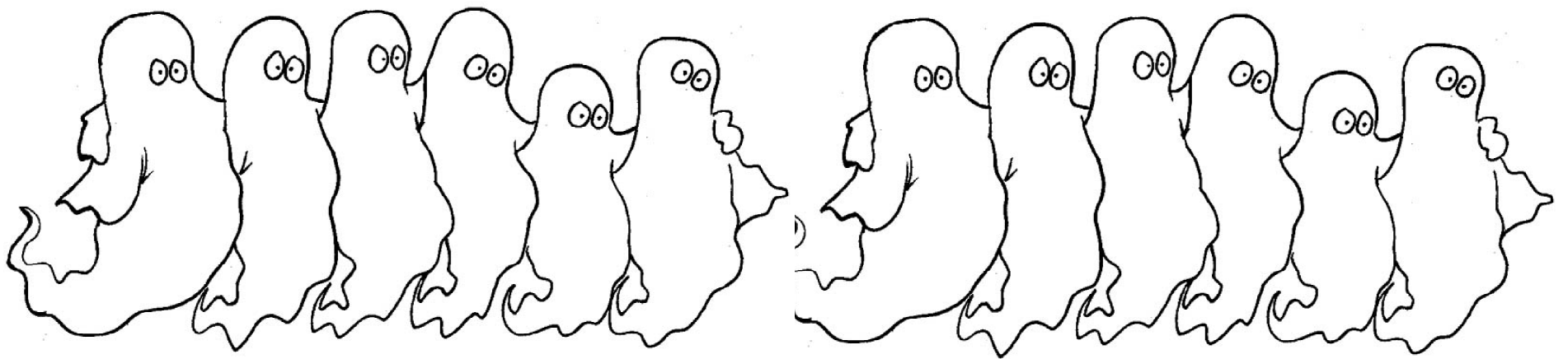
STAY in familiar neighborhoods.
